

OB AirMed is one of the few dedicated maternal transport teams in the nation, uniquely composed of both High Risk OB and Neonatal Flight Nurses. The team is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, for rapid transport of high-risk OB patients.

OB AirMed is committed to transporting OB patients when:

- The referring facility is not equipped to deal with the patient's actual or predicted obstetrical, medical, or surgical complications.
- Delivery of one or more infants that may require NBICU services greater than that available at the referring hospital.
- An obstetrical emergency occurs outside a hospital and transport is requested from the scene.
- Continuous specialty care by highly skilled personnel is needed during transport.
