FTP users outside the network:

You are receiving this e-mail message because your FTP account at ftp.uuhsc.utah.edu has been accessed from a computer outside the primary hospital network during the past few months. The reason you were identified as part of this group is so we could communicate an upcoming change in the FTP service that will affect you.

As of Monday, March 19th, FTP access from outside the main network to ftp.uuhsc.utah.edu will be blocked by the network firewall. This change is being made to comply with HIPAA regulations. This change means after March 19th you will no longer be able to use FTP from outside the main hospital network without making a security change. We appreciate your understanding as we work to ensure you can use this service without interruption.

To continue using this FTP service, you will need to make one of the changes below:

1. Use the VPN (Virtual Private Network) Service
2. Use Secure FTP (SFTP)
3. Work only from within the hospital network

All these options are currently available to all users but have not been required in the past. Please refer to the Web Resource Center's FTP website listed at the end of this message for additional details about which choice would be best for your situation and how to proceed. The sooner you begin the necessary change, the more time you will have to resolve any potential problems you may encounter before March 19th when this change goes into effect.

Please plan to make this change before March 19th.
