

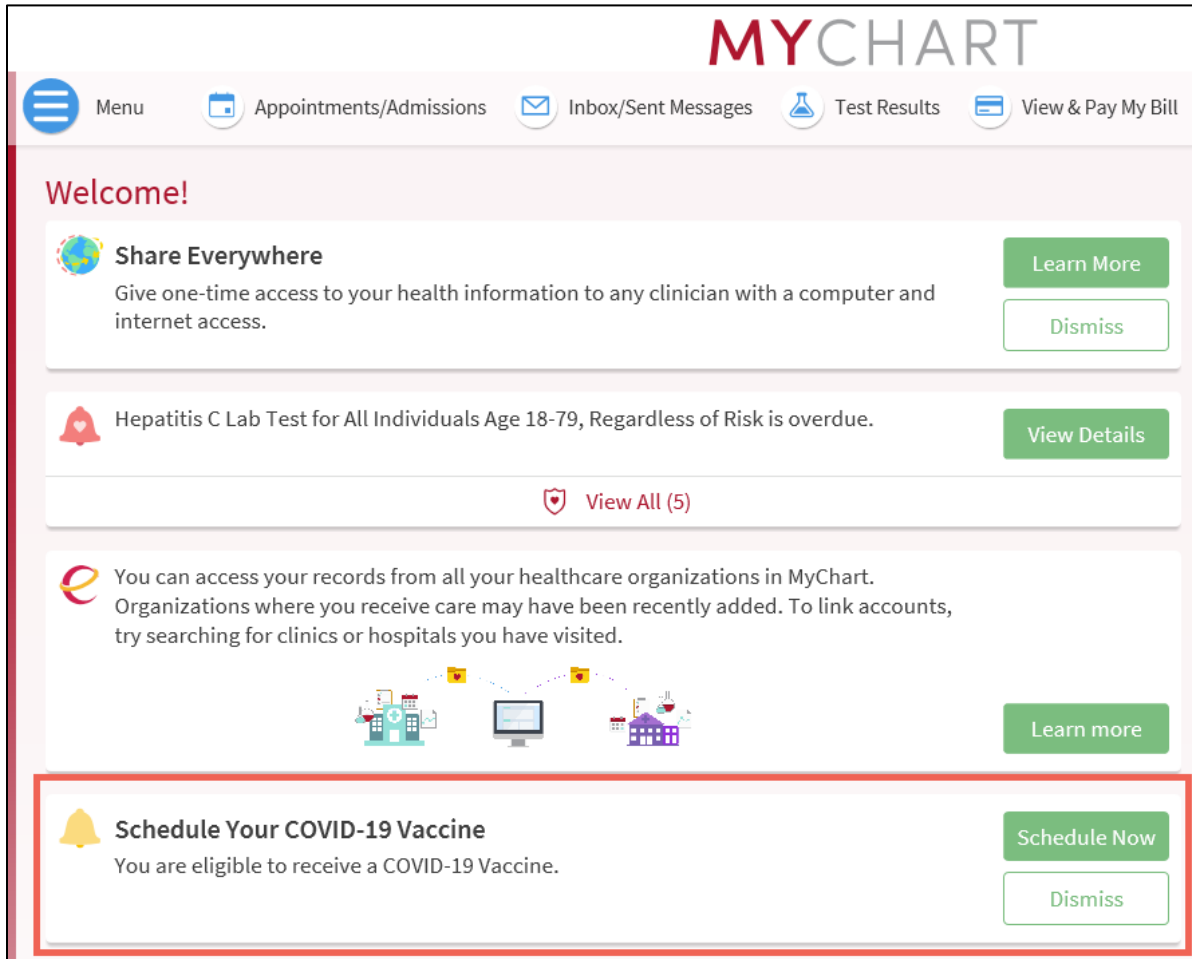
## MyChart - Schedule A COVID-19 Vaccine Appointment

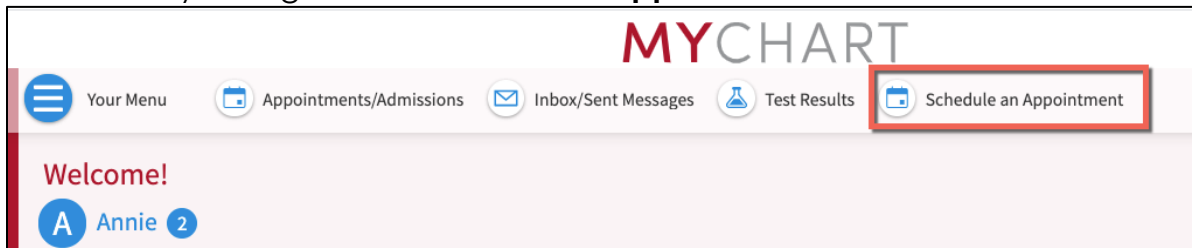

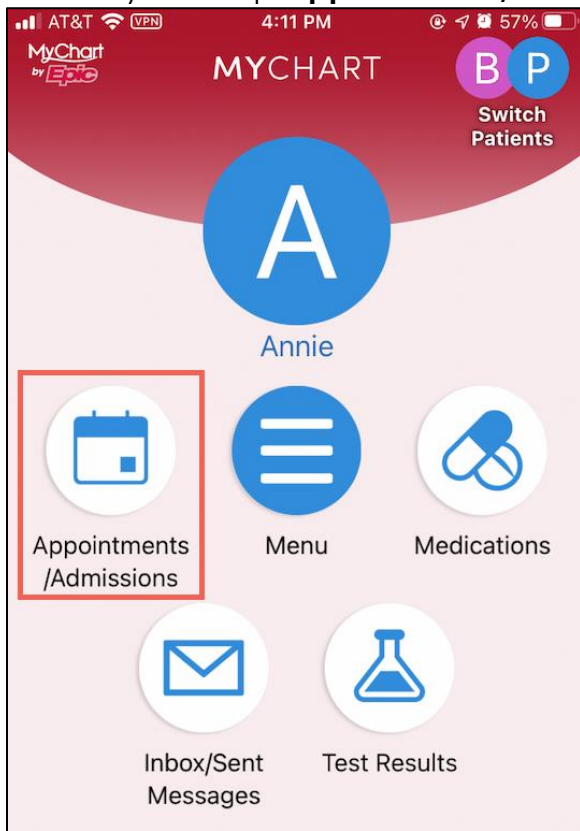
