

No-Sew Throw

SUPPLIES AND TOOLS

- Fleece fabric, 59-60 inches wide, 2 yards each layer. You can make both layers the same or choose a print and a coordinating solid.
- Scissors or rotary cutter & mat
- Tape measure

DIRECTIONS

Project tip: Cut both layers of fleece at the same time.

1. Place fleece rectangles wrong sides together.
2. Trim both pieces to a 56" x 70" rectangle at the same time.
3. Cut out a 7" square from each corner of both fleece pieces.
4. Make a fringe: cut 7" into fleece at 1" intervals around all sides of both pieces.
5. Knot fringed pieces together around entire blanket, using 1 strand from the front fabric layer and 1 strand from the back fabric layer.
