The Community Outreach and Prevention Education Program at Huntsman Cancer Institute offers internships for students studying health education, health promotion, public health, or related fields. Students **apply their education** to address cancer-related issues in the community while gaining **job experience** and **networking**.



Interns assist our health educators with needs assessments, program planning, grant writing, materials development, and service delivery. They conduct presentations and staff information booths in a variety of settings. Interns often specialize in a specific cancer type or cancer-related issue and participate in activities focused on that emphasis.

Qualifications

- Be a college senior or graduate student in a community health major or related field.
- Have reliable transportation and insurance.
- Commit to a minimum of three full days a week (250+ hours).
