

# About Mammograms

Having regular mammograms can save your life. Mammograms are able to detect cancers too small to feel with a self-exam and can find them early, when they are easier to treat. The American Cancer Society recommends women over 40 have a screening mammogram once a year. Utah has the second lowest rate of screening mammography in the country.

Our screening mammograms are done using full-field digital mammography equipment and evaluated by radiologists at Huntsman Cancer Hospital. Full-field digital mammography is similar to regular mammography in that a machine compresses the breast and takes a picture. But instead of a picture on film, digital mammography produces an electronic image on a computer. A digital image makes finding and diagnosing breast cancer quicker and easier because the image can be magnified and adjusted.

If your doctor recommends a follow-up evaluation, it will be at Huntsman Cancer Hospital. There, you have access to the latest breast imaging services:

- Breast ultrasound
- Tomosynthesis (3D mammography)
- Breast MRI
- Stereotactic breast biopsy
- Ultrasound-guided breast biopsy
- Radiologists specializing in breast imaging
