Please find the enclosed provisional license certificate for tissue bank operation for the following location:

The provisional license is effective until either June 1, 2020 or the issuance of a full license following an on-site survey of your tissue bank. Approval is limited to procurement and processing of eye tissue that is recovered and processed by tissue banks licensed by the Department in the requisite categories. The certificate, which has been amended to reflect the change in Medical Director, replaces that issued March 2, 2018. The certificate must be posted conspicuously at the approved location.

In accordance with the provisions of 10 NYCRR 52-3.7(d), the Department will require an annual summary of the activities of your tissue bank. Information to be reported may include the numbers of tissue donors, numbers of tissues recovered, numbers of tests for various infectious diseases, numbers of eye tissue specimens distributed, and outcomes of transplantation procedures reported by client facilities. Please report, in writing, any changes in tissue bank director or medical directors within five (5) days of the change. Also, report changes in direct or indirect ownership within thirty (30) days and keep the Department informed of any relocation of facilities.
